

DO Wear full uniform, including black school shoes. (See back page.)

Do ... Bring pencils, rubbers, sharpeners, rulers, colouring pencils to school.

Do ... Walk along the paths; **ONLY** cross the school lanes **AT THE ZEBRA CROSSINGS**.

Do ... Get dropped off and collected only in the church car park.

Do ... Go to, and stay in, your own playground in the morning.

Do ... Walk through the school and on the paths on the left-hand side.

Do ... Sit in your seats when eating at break-time and lunchtime.

Do ... Finish your meal in the dining room.

Do ... Go straight out to the playground once the play time bell has rung.

Do ... ~~Eat my shorts!~~

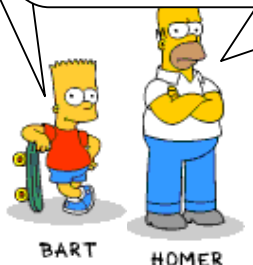
Doh! Don't Wear PE kit or trainers, except at PE time.

Don't ... Bring mobile phones, cameras, any electronic equipment, balls, sharp or pointy objects, dangerous items or chewing gum to school. (Educational toys & games may be brought in only at the teacher's invitation.)

Don't ... Go down the banks; walk along the lanes where there are cars; get out of cars on the lane; walk through the staff car parks.

Don't ... Go to other playgrounds; run in the corridors; walk around the classroom at break-time or lunchtime; take food or drink from the dining room.

Don't ... Go back to your room when you should be in the playground.



PARENTS, please

DO	DON'T
Do drop children off - and collect them - ONLY in the church car park.	Don't drop off or collect children on the school lanes.
Do PARK ONLY IN THE CHURCH CAR PARK OR IN THE TURNING CIRCLE Do walk along the <u>pedestrian</u> routes, <u>NOT</u> up the "in" lane or through the staff car parks A, B, C, D.	Don't PARK ON THE LANES, AT THE BUS BARRIER OR IN THE BUS LAY-BY . Don't wait, or let your children play, in the P4-7 playgrounds, especially between 2 and 4 pm.
Do contact the class teacher, in the first instance, if you have any concerns / queries.	Don't enter the school building without going first to the main office in the Infant School.
Do alert the teacher of any new information relevant to your child.	Don't try to speak to a teacher during teaching time or supervision times.
Do ensure that your child has the proper equipment and books for school each day and arrives in school on time.	Don't allow your children to bring banned or inappropriate items to school. (See list on opposite page.)
Do ensure that your child wears full school uniform - including <u>black school shoes</u> . (SEE BACK PAGE)	Don't let your child convince you that trainers are acceptable, except at PE times.

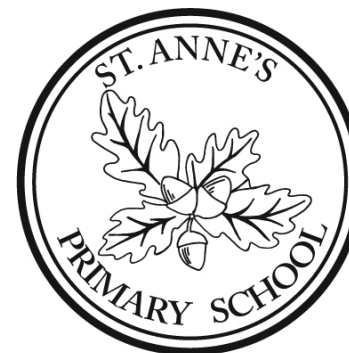
